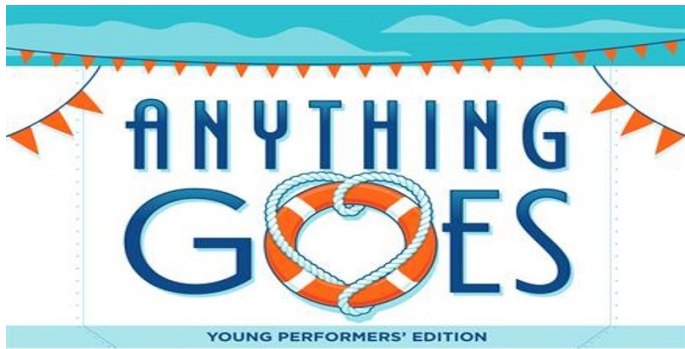

Auditions to participate January 4 or 7.

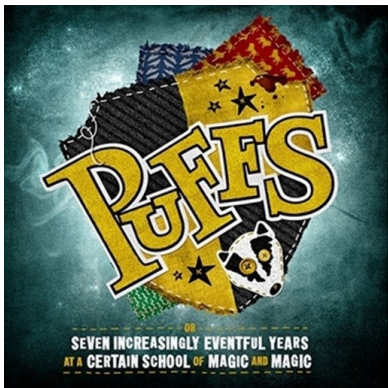
Performing March 18 and 19
